

Braemar 2012 Winter Junior Development Program

The Braemar Winter Junior Development program is designed for Junior players wanting to take their game to the next competitive level. The program offers instruction through both structured group practices and private lessons, all with 2011 Minnesota PGA Teacher of the Year Roger Fahrenkrug,

Players will focus on their fundamentals with the goal of developing repeating swings. Video analysis using the V1 Coaching System will help students compare their swings to the pros and allow them to visually identify areas for improvement. All players will be asked to create both pre-shot and post-shot routines to aid on-course focus. The group will compete in short game challenges and full-swing competitions. Players will also be evaluated for their golf fitness and provided with strengthening exercises.

The \$375.00 fee includes 6 private lessons, 10 one-hour supervised group sessions and practice aids. The group sessions are limited to 8 students per hour. Students can sign up for either the 3:30 - 4:30 or 4:30 - 5:30 time slot.

The 2012 supervised group session dates are Wednesday's January 11, 18, 25; February 1, 8, 15, 22; and March 14, 21, 28. The private lessons will be booked individually and all students should schedule their first private lesson before January 11.
